



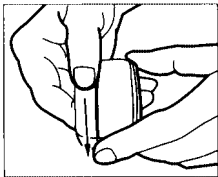
LOW BATTERY INDICATOR

When the battery level is low, the **LOW BATTERY** symbol  will be shown on the top of the screen.



BATTERY INFORMATION

This pager is designed to operate on one 'AAA'-size alkaline battery. The correct time and any stored messages will remain intact for up to five minutes after the battery is removed.



To install or replace the battery:

- Place the pager face down in the palm of your hand.
- Push with a click to unlock the battery door and slide it out as shown.
- Slide a new battery into the battery compartment.
- Ensure the pager is OFF and the battery polarity is correct.
- To close the battery cover, the dot on the cover must be aligned to the dot on the battery casing.

The Page is a **dynamic communication tool** used by over **150 million people** around the world. It is the **smallest, lightest** communication tool available. With its **fixed monthly subscription and low battery usage**, the pager is the most economical communication tool available. Over the years, paging utility has increased from **receiving numbers to text messages** and more.

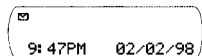

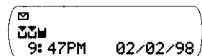
INFORMATION SERVICE

Your pager can even keep you up-to-date on the latest news. Information such as world news or financial reports can be received by the Aurora/Duo. (The extent of information received depends on your service provider. Please contact them for more details.)



When new information is received, the unread Information symbol will flash.

Press to enter Information Service mode.



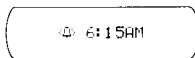
Press to read the highlighted information message

Press to move to the next message.

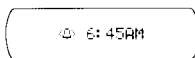


OUT-OF-RANGE

When your pager is out of the range of the paging system transmitter, the OUT-OF-RANGE indicator is shown on the top of the screen.



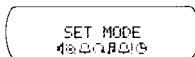
Press to highlight the minute field, then press to choose the minute.



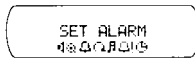
Press to highlight the **AM/PM** field, then press to choose either **AM/PM** field.
Press to set and exit.



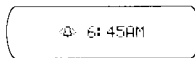

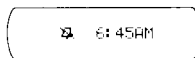
Press to enter **CONTROL MODE**.

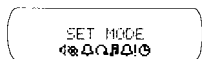
The Motorola Aurora/Duo offers a wide range of useful features.

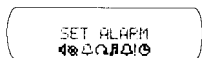


ALARM ON

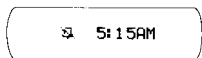
The alarm can be set to turn on at any time you specify.



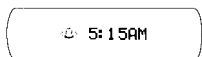
Press to enter CONTROL MODE.



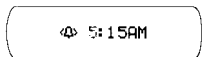
Press to select SET ALARM function.

Press to enable the alarm.

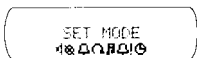


Press to highlight the hour field, then press to choose the hour.

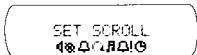


MESSAGE READING MODE

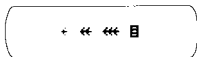
You can read your messages in two ways: either **LINE-BY-LINE** or the message can **SCROLL** automatically. There are three scroll speeds: **SLOW**, **MEDIUM** and **FAST**.

Press  to select **SET SCROLL** function.



Press  to enter **SET SCROLL** mode.



Press and release  to select your preferred scroll speed.


Press  to set and exit.

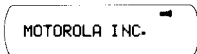

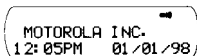
FUNCTION DETAILS

TURNING THE AURORA/DUO ON

Press



The pager will beep or vibrate. This Startup Screen will appear for a few seconds.
(Press to skip the Startup alert.)



The Message Status Screen shows the time and date and will only appear for a few seconds.



The Standby Screen shows the Standby Symbol

While in the Message Screen, press twice to enter Control Mode.
In the Standby Screen, press once to enter Control Mode.

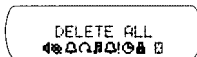


Press to delete the message.
Press to confirm and exit.

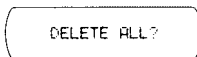
● All at once

Press to select DELETES ALL function.



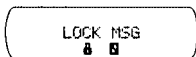
Press to delete the entire read and unlocked Messages.

If all the message slots are full and a new message has been received, the oldest, unlocked, read message is automatically deleted.

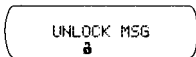
When the message memory is full, the MEMORY FULL icon is displayed.

● Unlocking Messages



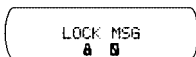
While reading the locked message, press  to enter MESSAGE CONTROL mode.
Press  to unlock the message.



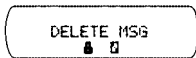
DELETING MESSAGES

● One-at-a-time



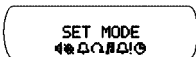
While reading an unlocked message, press  to enter MESSAGE CONTROL mode.



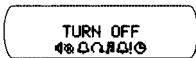
Press  to select DELETE MESSAGE.

Press  to set and exit.

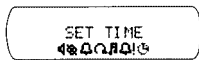
 All pager settings and messages in memory are retained even when the pager is turned off. The clock and alarm will continue to function. However, you will not receive any new pages.



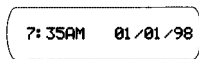
TIME & DATE



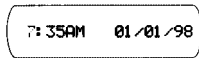
1. Press to enter **CONTROL MODE**.



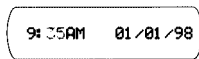
2. Press to select **SET TIME** function

4. Press to choose the hour.

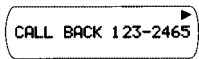


5. Press to highlight the minute field.

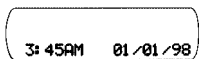

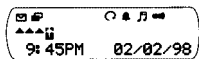
Press to view the rest of the message.

DUPLICATE MESSAGE



The Duplicate symbol is shown at the top of the screen if a duplicate message is received.

Press to read the message



LOCKING. UNLOCKING MESSAGES

Save messages by using the **LOCK** function. This also prevents important messages from being deleted when the memory is full. Messages can only be locked while reading them. Up to nine messages can be locked.



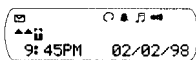
BACKLIGHT

To activate the screen backlight, press and hold for at least two seconds. The backlight automatically turns off after 12 seconds.



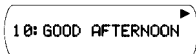
RECEIVING MESSAGES

When a message is received, the pager will alert you according to the alert mode that has been chosen (AUDIBLE, SILENT or SLEEP). If SLEEP has been chosen, the pager will only alert you when priority messages are received.



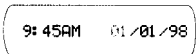
On receiving a message, your pager alerts you and the Unread Message symbol flashes. Press to read the highlighted message .

To move to the next message, press .

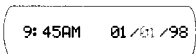


If the message is longer than the screen, the Arrow icon will appear the top-right corner.

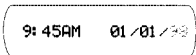

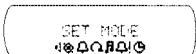

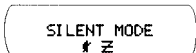


ALERT MODE

Press to enter ALERT MODE.



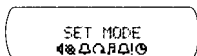
Press and release to select your favourite alert Mode.

Press  to set and exit.

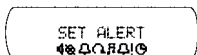
 In **SLEEP** mode, the pager will not alert you when a new page has been received.

Within the **AUDIBLE** alert mode, besides the standard alert, you may also choose from seven other **PLEASING ALERTS**.

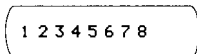

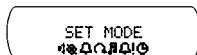

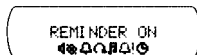

Use this feature to remind you of an unread message. If a message remains unread, a reminder chirp will sound at 2-minute intervals (for up to half an hour).



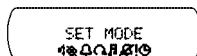

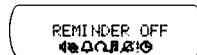
